- Performs other academic duties as assigned.

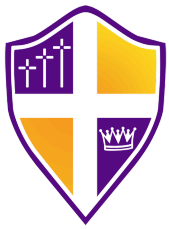

Responsibilities:

- Works with the CAA and other leagues on the coordination and management of the competition schedule (Soccer, Volleyball, Cross-Country, Basketball, Swimming)
- Coordination and management of the competition schedule for other co-curricular activities (Co-Ed Softball Lutheran Tournament for Gr. 5-8, Track & Field Days for Gr. 1-8)
- Coordination and management with Concordia Academy regarding student eligibility and facility use.
- Coordination and management of other co-curricular activities during the regular school day (Students vs. Staff Volleyball game in October, 7th vs. 8th Grade Basketball game in December)
- Communicate to families seasonally to provide athletic opportunities, expectations and program information
